

ECFA Online Grant Application Form for Project Funding 2026-27

Online applications close at midnight AEST on 30 June 2026, with successful applicants to be notified late July or August 2026.

All applications are to be prepared in English.

Optional supplementary information to be sent via email:

Supporting documentation for your project or activity can be provided by email to **supplement information in the online application form**.

We encourage you to do this if you have a **detailed budget** in Excel or Word format that includes all sources of project income (estimated grants and sponsorship funding, ticket and other commercial sales), and major planned items of expenditure).

If you have a **business plan** for your project or activity, you can also provide us a copy by email. Similarly, you can send images, testimonials or anything else to support your application. Supporting information can be in English or Estonian.

All supporting documentation should be sent to **ecfa@eesti.org.au** with the project or activity title that you use in your application in the subject line of the email to help cross-referencing. This should also be done before the deadline of **midnight AEST on 30 June 2026**.

Grant reporting obligations:

A report at the conclusion of the project (within 30 days but no later than 30 June 2027) will be required as a condition of any successful application. We also ask you to submit images from your project that can be used in promotional materials and on the ECFA website.

All applicants are required to acknowledge ECFA funding support on their web pages, Facebook, etc.

Every application requires a contact person for any ECFA queries and follow-up. The contact person will be responsible for supplying the grant report. Should the contact person change during the life of the project, ECFA should be notified of the change as soon as possible.
